Kate had been married for five years when she became pregnant. Her husband was ecstatic when he found out the news but Kate was terrified. I still remember the look of fear on her face when she told me over lunch. Her eyes seemed to say" Is there any way we can keep this baby in my uterus forever?" Seeing her approach the due date was like watching a condemned prisoner inch closer to an execution date. Kate, who had survived a terrible childhood herself, seemed to dread the delivery day. So it is understandable that everyone was shocked when only hours after holding her baby girl she exclaimed, "I'm ready for three more!"

What many people don't realize is that when a baby is born a parent is created as well. That evolution is one of the most lifechanging events a human being can experience.
